## Plants for Lizards

Shingleback Lizard or Sleepy Lizard



*Tiliqua rugosa*

Have been observed eating plant matter, snails, slugs and other lizards.

Food plant species include Aizoaceae spp, Santalaceae spp, Pittosporaceae spp.

**BILLADIERA cymosa** 'Sweet Apple-berry'

H: to 2m. Twining perennial, flowers blue star shaped in spring & Summer. Enjoys free draining soils.

**Uses:** Fruits edible. Screen, rockery, or container plant.

**Habitat Uses:** Birds attracted to seed. Lizards attracted to fruits.

CARPOBROTUS rossii



**CARPOBROTUS rossii 'Pig Face'**

Groundcover creeper, flowers bright pink in Winter & Spring. Suits most soils. Full sun

or part shade. Quick Growth. Fruits edible.

**Uses:** Small garden, Rockery.

**Habitat value:** Bird & Lizard attracting

**SANTALUM acuminatum 'Quandong'**

H: to 5m. A small tree with light olive green leaves older leaves are often quite thick. Flowers usually from October to May. Fruits are green when unripe then bright cherry red when ripe.

**Uses:** Fruit edible and seeds are ornamental.

**Habitat Uses:** Lizards & Birds attracted to fruit.
